The seminar's primary thematic focus is contemporary (20<sup>th</sup>- and 21<sup>st</sup>- century) Anglophone cultural and literary studies. In that, the seminar has two distinct but interrelated goals:

- to help participants develop and conceptualize their doctoral projects;
- to expand their critical understanding of contemporary Anglophone cultures through a series of readings and discussions.

The readings will be selected at the beginning of the semester depending on the disciplinary specializations and research interests of seminar participants. The course will be taught in English.

The ASC Doctoral Seminar in Cultural Studies will be offered every semester, but will be taught by different instructors to ensure a diversity of theoretical and methodological perspectives.
