"CONTINUITY AND CONTACT: LANGUAGE AND MATERIAL CULTURE AT THE ROOTS OF EUROPEAN DIVERSITY"

to be held online on June 10, 2022

This graduate seminar focuses on developments, contacts and transformations of **languages**, **cultures** and **societies** preceding the European Modern Age.

We aim to discuss novel methodologies for dealing with material culture, new modes of linguistic reconstruction in societal contexts, and new approaches to cultural identities in early (pre)history. Disciplinary, transdisciplinary and contrastive perspectives are welcome. Methodological connections to Digital Humanities are particularly welcome.

This is an invitation to researchers, PhD students and advanced MA students to participate and present their research in this special area of interest. We initially plan a one-day seminar, but depending on the number of participants this can be extended.
