Scientific activity of the candidate – assessment rules

Scientific activity of the candidate is preliminarily assessed by two members of the qualification team who agree the grades with each other. The agreed preliminary grades are presented to the rest of the team. After the discussion, the team determines the final grades. In case of no unanimity of the members, the final evaluation is determined by voting.

Grades are given in accordance with the table below.

<i>Scientific activity of the candidate (15)</i>	0-15
scientific publications (front page; percentage share of the candidate's participation)	3 journal, 2 arXiv, bioRxiv <i>(for each)</i>
participation in student competitions (confirmation)	3 laureate, 2 participation <i>(for each)</i>
participation in research projects (certificate issued by the project coordinator)	3 <i>(for each)</i>
seminar or conference presentations or messages (confirmation)	2 home university, 3 greater coverage <i>(for each)</i>
research internships (documented; not identical to the project)	3 <i>(for each)</i>
achievements within students' research groups (certificate signed by the chairperson of the group)	3 organization, 2 participation <i>(for each)</i>

If the sum of the category grades exceeds 15, the total grade for the criterion "Scientific activity of the candidate" is 15.
