The seminar's primary thematic focus is contemporary (20th- and 21st-century) Anglophone cultural and literary studies. In that, the seminar has two distinct but interrelated goals:

- to help participants develop and conceptualize their doctoral projects;
- to expand their critical understanding of contemporary Anglophone cultures through a series of readings and discussions.

The readings will be selected at the beginning of the semester depending on the disciplinary specializations and research interests of seminar participants. The course will be offered in English. (If all participants are Polish-speakers, discussions may switch to Polish; all readings will be in English.)
